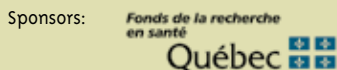

**Summary**

The 2011 4<sup>th</sup> Medications and Pregnancy Symposium offers an opportunity to share knowledge on the risks and benefits for mothers and children of taking medications during pregnancy. Given that Health Canada does not permit the inclusion of pregnant women in clinical trials, little information on the safety and risk of medication use during pregnancy is available before medications come onto the market. The target audience for this one-day symposium will be general practitioners/family medicine physicians, OB/GYNs, pharmacists and nurses who provide care to pregnant women as well as researchers and graduate students/fellows in perinatal care.

**Objectives**

The 2011 4<sup>th</sup> Medications and Pregnancy Symposium will focus on the following topics:

1. Treating migraines during pregnancy.
2. Impact of taking high doses of folic acid during pregnancy.
3. Antidepressants, benzodiazepines and the use of other anti-psychotics during pregnancy, genetic predisposition and psychological effect on the mother and child.
4. Roundtable discussion on the Quebec assisted reproduction techniques reimbursement program.
5. Medications and pregnancy—the French experience
